

### The Grand Theatre Giacomo Puccini

The *Gran Teatro all'aperto Giacomo Puccini* is located in the Giacomo Puccini Music and Sculpture Park whose realisation (2008) represents one of the most significant interventions in the field of cultural policy in Tuscany in recent decades. The new theatre, made of concrete, wood and crystal, stands on a surface of 7,500 square metres: the Arena seats 3,370 spectators while the auditorium below has a capacity of about 400 seats.

## Firenze Walking Tour



The cradle of the Renaissance awaits you!

Explore the main attractions with **City Florence Tours** and discover the history of the city of Florence through a 2-hour **guided walking tour** that will allow you to walk around the city squares, discovering the fascinating Florentine history. You will cross the Ponte Vecchio and admire the small jewelers that are an integral part of it and that were formerly butchers.

You will walk outside the **Uffizi Gallery**, passing under the **Vasari Corridor** and arriving in **Piazza della Signoria**, where you will be enchanted by the grandeur and beauty of the **Palazzo Vecchio** and the statues that compose it, on all one of the two copies of **David** and the statue of Neptune.

Continuing along Via Calzaiuoli, you will arrive at the **Duomo** complex, composed of Giotto's Bell Tower, the Cathedral of Santa Maria Del Fiore, the Baptistery and the immense Dome designed and built by **Filippo Brunelleschi**. Then you will continue from the district of Dante Alighieri to the church of **Orsanmichele**.

Your guide will show you the resting place of the artists and architects who have worked in Florence, also accompanying you to see the fascinating **Basilica of Santa Croce**, burial site of Michelangelo, Galileo Galilei, Machiavelli and Rossini, and one of the greatest Gothic works in Italy.



## Excursion to Cinque Terre by ferry or train (Private Tour)



Meeting with the guide in La Spezia, where by ferry we reach **Portovenere**, a medieval village built on one of the promontories of the Gulf of Poets. During the stop of an hour we can visit this fortified hamlet, nestled between the cliffs of Muzzerone mount and Palmaria Island and we will reach Saint Peter Church (one of the most charming places in the world, built over the sea). Our itinerary continues, always by ferry, towards Cinque Terre, which we can admire from the sea. We reach **Monterosso**, where we have lunch. In the old town, among narrow streets and picturesque shops, we will visit Saint John Church (elegant example of Ligurian Gothic) and the seventeenth–century oratory of the Blacks Brotherhood. After lunch and Monterosso visit, we move by train towards **Riomaggiore**, stop and guided tour to the picturesque marina. Then we come back to La Spezia by train. ## Excursion to Cinque Terre by Ferry Boat (Private Tour)



Meeting with the guide in La Spezia. The itinerary starts in Manarola (reachable by bus too). Visit to the picturesque village, with small streets, the mills, the marina, observing the typical terraced vineyards where Cinque Terre wines are produced. We will walk for a short tract the Sentiero Azzurro (Light Blue Path) and we will reach Punta Bonfiglio, a beautiful viewpoint where we can admire the perched village of Corniglia.

Late in the morning, we move towards Monterosso village for lunch. In the most ancient part of the hamlet, now important seaside resort, it is possible to visit Saint John the Baptist Church and the oratory of the Blacks Brotherhood.

After lunch, by train or by boat we reach Vernazza, with its marina and Santa Margherita d'Antiochia church, which overlooks the sea. Then return to La Spezia.

Length: a Day or half day

## Cinque Terre by Bike (Private Tour)



An amazing Full-Day eBike excursion.

Meet your guide at 8.30am out of La Spezia Central Train Station. Start the tour from **Biassa**, a small fraction of La Spezia. Cycling with our fantastic pedalassisted bikes you go up, through thick chestnut woods, up to the Telegrafo hill, where the sea air arrives with strength and the Mediterranean maquis begins to be predominant.

We continue on a path through breathtaking landscapes to **Volastra**, a beautiful village surrounded by the famous terraced vineyards. Next stop **Manarola**, where there will be an aperitif with local wine tasting.

Afterwards free time to visit the village, have lunch and relax. In the afternoon return to La Spezia cycling along the scenic road with beautiful views of the villages and the sea.
